POOL PARTY

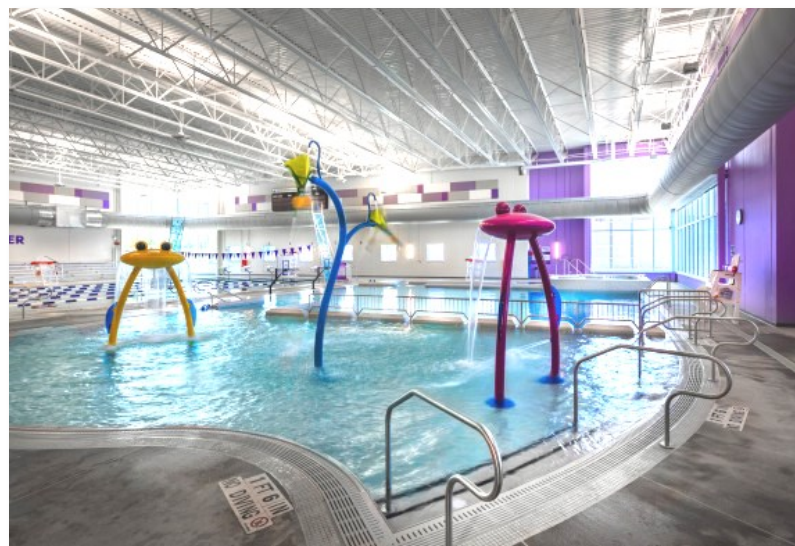
- * 2.5 hours in the pool & party room
- * Up to 20 swimmers
- * Additional swimmers are \$6/person

OPTIONS:

Fridays 4:00-7:00pm
 Saturdays 1:00-4:00pm
 Sundays 11:00-2:00pm

Cost: \$150/Member & \$175/Non-member

All parties are welcome to bring in food, cake & decorations in the party room.



BIRTHDAY PARTY RULES (for both Adventure Center & Pool Parties):

- A party includes up to 20 children for adventure center or 20 swimmers (children and adults included) for the pool plus a room for food & drinks.
- There is a \$6 fee per additional child in the Adventure Center or swimmer over the 20 included.
- A \$25 non-refundable deposit is due to book & remaining balance is due 2 weeks prior to the party.
- Swimmers will receive a wristband when they arrive for the pool party.
- All guests must sign in on our guest waiver form so we know who is present in the building, staff will also stamp their wrist.
- Adults 18+ years old must also provide birthdates as we reserve the right to run background checks on all guests at the South Wood County YMCA.
- Both the Pool and Adventure Center is still open for members during parties, but Party rooms are private for party guests.

ADVENTURE CENTER RULES:

- Party room is the Conference Room
- Play structure is designed for children ages 3-12.
- Toys are not allowed on the play structure.
- Socks must be worn in the Adventure Center at all times, no shoes allowed on the structure.
- No food is allowed in the Adventure Center – food and drinks MUST stay in the conference room.
- By the end of the party, make sure all used toys are picked up and put back in place.
- Read over the posted safety rules with the children prior to the party – example, no running up the slides, no sliding on stomachs, walking feet, no climbing on the nets, etc.

POOL RULES:

- Party room is the Teaching Kitchen
- Children under 8 years old MUST have an adult in the water within arm's reach at all times.
- Children 8 and over must be capable of swimming independently, in order to be left unattended during recreation swim.
- No glass or ceramic containers are allowed in the pool area or locker rooms.
- No food, drinks or gum are allowed in the pool.
- No mermaid tails are allowed.
- All participants must rinse off in the shower before entering the pool.
- No diving allowed in the recreation pool.
- No running or rough housing: dunking, pushing, spitting water, hanging on or throwing others.
- Excessive breath holding is prohibited.
- No abusive/vulgar language.
- People with open sores and cuts are not to use the pool or spa.
- Please remove band aids prior to entering the water.
- No person suffering from communicable disease transmissible via water or under the influence of an intoxicating liquor or drug shall use the pool or spa.
- Please do not use the pool or spa if you are ill with vomiting or diarrhea.
